

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$4,000.00 FROM VARIOUS CITY COUNCIL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FUNDS, PAYABLE TO THE U.S. MILITARY VETERANS PARADE ASSOCIATION, TO BE USED TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE 2002 U.S. MILITARY VETERANS PARADE TO BE HELD ON SATURADAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2002; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN ENRIQUE M. BARRERA.

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WHEREAS, Councilman Enrique M. Barrera, District 6, has requested Council concurrence for the expenditure of \$1,000.00 from the Council District 6 Contingency Fund to help defray the costs associated with the 2002 U.S. Military Veterans Parade to be held on Saturday, November 9, 2002; and

WHEREAS, in addition, Council Members Edward Garza, Mayor (\$1,500.00), David A. Garcia, District 5 (1,000.00) and Bonnie Conner, District 8 (\$500.00), have requested Council concurrence for expenditures from their respective "District Contingency Accounts," in the amounts indicated, similarly to assist the 2002 U.S. Military Veterans Parade; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to authorize the expenditure as requested by Councilman Enrique M. Barrera, **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The request of Councilman Enrique M. Barrera, District 6, for payment from the "District 6 Contingency Budget Account" in the total amount of \$1,000.00 to the U.S. Military Veterans Parade Association, for the purpose set out above is hereby approved and authorized. A copy of Councilman Barrera's request is set out in Attachment I.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$4,000.00 is encumbered for payment from the following Contingency Budget Accounts and made payable to the San Antonio Area Disability Advocates Organization:

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the U.S. Military Veterans Parade Association in the amount of \$4,000.00 for costs set out above. A copy of the "Agreement to Use Funds of the City of San Antonio" is attached hereto and appearing in substantially the same form as Attachment II.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth (10th) day after the passage hereof.
