

AN ORDINANCE **96649**

**AMENDING THE CONTRACT WITH RCC CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR CONTINUED ON-SITE PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND CONSULTING SERVICES TO THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND BEXAR COUNTY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND IMPLEMENTATION AND THE 800 MHZ PUBLIC SAFETY RADIO SYSTEM IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$568,500.00; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.**

(Amends Ordinance 90320, August 19, 1999)

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance Number 90320 passed on August 19, 1999, approved a professional services contract with RCC Consultants, Inc., for project management and consulting services for the 800 MHZ Public Safety Radio System; and

**WHEREAS**, continue using the services of RCC Consultants, Inc. and to appropriate funds in the amount not to exceed \$568,500.00 for continued on-site project management and consulting services to the City of San Antonio and Bexar County; and

**WHEREAS**, approval of this Ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy for the 800 MHZ Public Safety Radio System, as approved through Ordinance Number 90320; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.**The professional services contract with RCC Consultants, Inc. for project management and consulting services for the 800 MHZ Public Safety Radio System, approved through Ordinance Number 90320 passed on August 19, 1999, is hereby extended and amended in accordance herewith, and the additional funds in an amount not to exceed \$568,500.00 are hereby authorized.

**SECTION 2.** All other terms and conditions of the professional services contract shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3.** Funds in the amount not to exceed \$568,500.00 are authorized to be encumbered in Fund 40-009001 (Other Capital Projects/Public Safety Radio System Phase III Project Fund), in Index Code 658021 entitled "Professional Services Contract", and are made payable to RCC Consultants, Inc.

**SECTION 4.** The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall be effective on November 10, 2002.
