

AN ORDINANCE **96659**

AUTHORIZING A FIREWORKS DISPLAY AT AN OPEN AREA ACROSS FROM FREEMAN COLISEUM FOR THE SAN ANTONIO SPURS' OPENING GAME TO BE HELD AT APPROXIMATELY 6:00 P.M. ON FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 2002 WITH NO RAIN DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE UPON PASSAGE BY EIGHT (8) AFFIRMATIVE VOTES.

WHEREAS, Alpha-Lee Enterprises, Inc. wishes to conduct a fireworks display at approximately 6:00 p.m. on Friday, November 1, 2002, at an open area across from Freeman Coliseum for the San Antonio Spurs' Opening Game; and


WHEREAS, the required display permits and insurance documentation have been filed with the Fire Marshall's Office; **NOW THEREFORE:**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Alpha-Lee Enterprises, Inc. is hereby authorized to conduct a fireworks display at approximately 6:00 p.m. on Friday, November 1, 2002, at an open area across from Freeman Coliseum for the San Antonio Spurs' Opening Game.

SECTION 2. Because the fireworks display for the San Antonio Spurs' Opening Game is scheduled to be held less than ten days from the date of passage of this Ordinance and because this Ordinance is necessary to provide for the public peace, property, health, and safety, an emergency is hereby declared. Upon the affirmative vote of at least eight members of the City Council, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately; otherwise, it will become effective ten days from the date of passage.
