

AN ORDINANCE **96682**

AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE IN THE CONSTRUCTION CONTINGENCIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,714.36 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF GATE GOURMET/PIEDMONT DRIVEWAY AS PART OF THE LOT 9 DEMOLITION & UPGRADE AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT; REVISING THE BUDGET; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.

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WHEREAS, the City has in its Five Year Capital Program, a program to improve roadway access through the Lot 9 Demolition & Upgrade Project at San Antonio International Airport; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 95946, passed and approved on June 20, 2002, authorized a construction contract with ASC Paving for the construction of Gate Gourmet/Piedmont driveway at San Antonio International Airport; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance appropriated the amount of \$4,500.00 for construction contingencies; and

WHEREAS, during initial construction, utility conflicts were discovered which must be adjusted to accommodate the new construction; and

WHEREAS, the costs for this additional work is \$8,829.70; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide for future contingencies it is necessary to increase the construction contingencies in the amount of \$6,714.36, from \$4,500.00 to \$11,214.36; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to appropriate funds, and provide for payment; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$6,714.36 is appropriated in the Airport Improvement & Contingency Fund No. 51-013 to Project No. 51-013140 and therein to Expenditure Account Index No. as indicated below. Said amount is authorized to be encumbered in and disbursed, up to the amount indicated, from Project No. 51-013140 and from Expenditure Account Index No. as indicated.





SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.
