

AN ORDINANCE **96690**

**CHANGING THE STREET NAME OF THE 4500 BLOCK OF SISK
TO CHARLES WILLIAMS PLACE .**

WHEREAS, Councilman John Sanders has requested that the 4500 block of the street known as "Sisk" be changed to "Charles Williams Place" in honor of Mr. Williams's commitment and contributions to District 2; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Postal Service, the City Public Service were informed of the proposed new name and did not state any objections to the name change; and

WHEREAS, after requisite notice of the request to change the name of the street, the street Name Change Committee comprised of Councilmember John Sanders, a representative for Development Services Director Florencia Pena, and a representative for Public Works Director Thomas Wendorf, met on October 8, 2002 at a public hearing to consider renaming the street to "Robinson Place"; and

WHEREAS, upon receiving Unified Development Code approval, as required by the Ordinance, the Committee elected to forward the request to City Council; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The 4500 block of the street currently named "Sisk" is hereby renamed "Charles Williams Place".


SECTION 2. City staff are directed to take the necessary action to ensure that said renaming is properly promulgated as soon as possible following the effective date of this ordinance.
