

AN ORDINANCE **96716**

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE, TO ACCEPT A \$16,023.00 SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT FROM THE TEXAS AUTOMOBILE THEFT PREVENTION AUTHORITY (“ATPA”) FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AND TRAVEL FOR USE IN THE SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT’S EFFORT IN REDUCING AUTO THEFT.

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WHEREAS, through Ordinance No. 96198, passed and approved on August 15, 2002, the City Council accepted a grant from the Texas Automobile Theft Prevention Authority (“ATPA”) to enhance the City’s efforts in dealing with auto theft; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Automobile Theft Prevention Authority (“ATPA”) has offered supplemental grant funds in the amount of \$16,023.00 for the purchase of equipment and travel for use in the San Antonio Police Department’s effort in reducing auto theft; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of these supplemental grant funds will result in a total revised budget of \$3,205,782.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designated representative, is hereby authorized to accept a supplemental grant in the amount of \$16,023.00 from the Texas Automobile Theft Prevention Authority (“ATPA”) to purchase equipment and travel for use in the San Antonio Police Department’s effort in reducing auto theft. The amount of the supplemental grant will be added to the original grant, bringing the total revised budget to \$3,205,782.00. Ordinance No. 96198, passed and approved on August 15, 2002, is hereby authorized to be revised in accordance herewith. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute any necessary documentation to effect said supplemental grant.

SECTION 2. Fund No. 26-031012 is authorized to be revised as set out in the detailed budget attached hereto as Attachment I.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
