

AN ORDINANCE **96747**

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO A DELEGATE AGENCY CONTRACT WITH HELPING HANDS LIFELINE FOUNDATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,200.00 FOR THE PROVISION OF FOOD, CLOTHING, RENTAL, UTILITY BILL ASSISTANCE AND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE TO FAMILIES AND INDIVIDUALS THROUGHOUT SAN ANTONIO; AND AUTHORIZING ALLOCATION AND EXPENDITURE OF HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNTS OF \$100.00 FROM DISTRICT 1, \$500.00 FROM DISTRICT 2, \$500.00 FROM DISTRICT 3, \$500.00 FROM DISTRICT 4, \$600.00 FROM DISTRICT 5, \$1,000.00 FROM DISTRICT 6, \$500.00 FROM DISTRICT 7, \$500.00 FROM DISTRICT 8, \$500.00 FROM DISTRICT 9, AND \$500.00 FROM DISTRICT 10 IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN ENRIQUE BARRERA.

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WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio presently subcontracts with Helping Hands Lifeline Foundation to operate the Emergency Assistance Program pursuant to a delegate agency contract that was executed on October 25, 2002 pursuant to Ordinance No. 96399; and

WHEREAS, the Helping Hands Lifeline Foundation provides emergency assistance, in the form of food, clothing, rental and utility bill assistance and medical expenses to families and individuals throughout San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2002, Councilmember Enrique Barrera distributed a six-signature memorandum requesting to place as a City Council Agenda item the authorization to use Human Development Services Funds from District 6 in the amount of \$1,000.00 for general operational expenditures for the Helping Hands Lifeline Foundation; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Barrera also requested that other Council members consider contributing Human Development Services Funds for the general operational expenditures for the Helping Hands Lifeline Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the Councilmembers desire to contribute human development funds totalling \$5,200.00 for the provision of additional services by the Helping Hands Lifeline Foundation; and

WHEREAS, it is now the desire of the City Council to amend the City's delegate agency contract with the Helping Hands Lifeline Foundation to increase the amount of the contract by \$5,200.00 for the provision of additional services; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute an amendment to the delegate agency contract with Helping Hands Lifeline Foundation in the amount of \$5,200.00 for the provision of food, clothing, rental and utility bill assistance and medical assistance to families and individuals throughout San Antonio. A copy of the contract amendment is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.


SECTION 2. The budget in Fund 11-000000 (General Fund) in the following index codes is authorized for reduction by \$5,200.00.


