

AN ORDINANCE **9 6 7 7 7**

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A CASH GRANT AWARD OF \$25,000.00 FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (TDH) TO FUND THE ONGOING SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT (SAMHD) CHILDHOOD LEAD POISONING PREVENTION PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2002 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2003; APPROVING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH TDH; REVISING THE BUDGET FOR THE PUBLIC HEALTH STATE SUPPORT PROJECT 2002/2003 ESTABLISHED IN ORDINANCE NO. 95200 PASSED AND APPROVED JANUARY 24, 2002; AND APPROVING THE PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Health (TDH) provides annual financial assistance to the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) to supplement the delivery of comprehensive public health services to protect the health of all residents within the jurisdiction of the District; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 95200, passed and approved on January 24, 2002 authorized the execution of Contract 7460020708 2003 between SAMHD and TDH, which covered the operation of the Public Health State Support Project 2002/2003 of the SAMHD; and

WHEREAS, the TDH has now offered a cash grant award of \$25,000.00 to fund the ongoing Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program in the SAMHD through Contract Change Notice No. 10 for the period July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize the acceptance of the cash grant award from the TDH, approve the execution of the contract change notice, revise the budget of the Public Health State Support Project 2002/2003, and approve the personnel complement; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to accept Contract Change Notice No. 10, Attachment No. 17, to Grant Contract 7460020708 2003, with the Texas Department of Health (TDH), which provides \$25,000.00 in cash to fund the ongoing Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program in the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) for the period July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute this Contract Change with TDH. A copy of Contract Change Notice No. 10 is set out in Attachment II and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. The account entitled "Public Health State Support Project 2002/2003 - Federal, Fund No. 26-016052 has previously been designated for use in the accounting for this Project. This fund is authorized to be revised in accordance with Contract Change Notice No. 10.

SECTION 4. The sum of \$25,000.00 is hereby appropriated in the above-designated fund and the budget set out in Attachment I is approved and adopted for entry on the City books.


SECTION 5. The one (1) personnel position set out in Attachment I is hereby authorized for the activity thereon.



SECTION 7. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth day after passage hereof.
