

AN ORDINANCE **96795**

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$250.00 FROM THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF FOUR (4) ALL-WAY STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF ROGERS RANCH PARKWAY AND CROSTIMBER/FALLING BROOK; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN CARROLL W. SCHUBERT, DISTRICT 9.

WHEREAS, traffic counts were collected on July 9, 2002 for the intersection of Rogers Ranch Parkway and Crosstimber/Falling Brook to determine whether changes in traffic control were needed and though the volume has increased, the traffic movements are similar now to those that existed previously; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices sets out an outline of necessary conditions that must be met before an all-way stop sign could be installed; and

WHEREAS, Councilman Carroll W. Schubert has requested Council concurrence in placing four all-way stop signs at the intersection of Rogers Ranch Parkway and Crosstimber/Falling Brook; and

WHEREAS, approval of this ordinance will require installation of a traffic control device at a location in anticipation that the traffic count will meet criteria in the near future; **NOW THEREFORE**,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The Public Works Department is authorized to install four all-way stop signs at the intersection of Rogers Ranch Parkway and Crosstimber/Falling Brook.


SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$250.00 for the traffic control device by the City of San Antonio Public Works Department is hereby authorized to be made from the Public Works Traffic Operations Budget.
