**ACKNOWLEDGING USE OF THE MATRICULA
CONSULAR ISSUED BY THE MEXICAN CONSULATE AS
A FORM OF IDENTIFICATION FOR CITY PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the Mexican Consulate issues an identification card called the "Matricula Consular" to Mexican nationals who have resided in the United States for at least six months and who comply with identification requirements established by the Mexican government; and

WHEREAS, presently 46 other U.S. cities accept the "Matricula Consular" as a form of identification; **NOW THEREFORE**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

That the City Council acknowledges the "Matricula Consular" as a form of identification; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

That the City Council directs the City Manager to determine which departments, programs and services of the City of San Antonio will accept the "Matricula Consular" as an appropriate form of identification.
