

AN ORDINANCE **9 6 9 3 0**

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A "LETTER OF INTENT" TO SEEK FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000.00 FOR THE THIRD YEAR OF THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TxDOT) DWI SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM (STEP), FOR THE CONTINUED FUNDING OF AN OVERTIME PROGRAM FOR DWI ENFORCEMENT, FOR THE GRANT PERIOD OCTOBER 1, 2003 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2004.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has grant funds available for the third year of a three-year Highway Safety Program grant to provide increased DWI enforcement through the use of police officer overtime; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is October 1, 2003 to September 30, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Police Department was awarded first-year grant funds for FY2001-02 and second-year grant funds for FY2002-03; and

WHEREAS, an award of third year grant funds requires matching contributions as follows: \$39,392.00 in in-kind contributions and \$127,274.00 in cash contributions; and

WHEREAS, TxDOT requires that a letter of intent be submitted requesting third-year grant funds and committing to continuation of the police officer overtime program;

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to submit a letter of intent to the Texas Department of Transportation for third-year grant funds to provide increased DWI enforcement through the use of police offer overtime. A copy of the letter of intent shall be kept in the Office of the Chief of Police.


SECTION 2. Funding will be accomplished by way of a subsequent Ordinance should the grant funds be awarded.
