

AN ORDINANCE **9 6957**

ACCEPTING THE SOLE SOURCE OFFER FROM SAGEM MORPHO, INC. TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH UPGRADED SOFTWARE AND HARDWARE TO THE EXISTING AUTOMATIC FINGERPRINT IDENTIFYING SYSTEM (AFIS) FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$1,499,250.00.

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WHEREAS, a proposal was submitted by Sagem Morpho, Inc., a sole source supplier, to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with upgraded software and hardware to the existing automatic fingerprint identifying system (AFIS) for a total amount of \$1,499,250.00; and

WHEREAS, this contract will provide upgrades to the AFIS system providing police officers with a system capable of identifying suspects in a mobile environment; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(7)(A) which provides for any items that are available only from a sole source of supply, nor is it required under section 252.022(a)(2) for procurements affecting the public health and safety; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The proposal submitted by Sagem Morpho, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with upgraded software and hardware to the existing automatic fingerprint identifying system (AFIS) for a total amount of \$1,499,250.00 is hereby accepted. A copy of the contract and bid tabulation sheet are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. The encumbrance in fund 45-939007, 1999 Public Safety, in index code 514950, entitled Computer Hardware, is reduced by \$1,499,250.00.

SECTION 3. In fund 45-939007, 1999 Public Safety, in index code 514950, entitled Computer Hardware, the amount of \$1,499,250.00 is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to Sagem Morpho, Inc., for upgraded software and hardware for the existing Automatic Fingerprint Identifying System, in connection with the Public Safety Integrated Technology System Project.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the

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
City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
