

AN ORDINANCE **9 6 9 1 8**

RATIFYING A CONTRACT WITH NEXTEL COMMUNICATIONS TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH COMBINATION CELLULAR COMMUNICATION RADIO UNITS AND SERVICE ON AN ANNUAL CONTRACT BASIS FOR AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$29,142.75.

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WHEREAS, a proposal was submitted by Nextel Communications, a sole source supplier, to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with combination cellular communication radio units and service for an estimated cost of \$29,142.75; and

WHEREAS, this contract will provide for the purchase of forty-two combination cellular/radio 800MHz units and associated communications service which will be used in undercover police operations and are necessary to ensure confidential communications among the officers; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(2) for procurements necessary to preserve or protect the public health and safety, or under 252.022(a)(7) for procurements of items that are available from only one source; and

WHEREAS, this contract began on August 8, 2002 and will terminate on August 8, 2003; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The contract with Nextel Communications to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with combination cellular communication radio units and service for an estimated cost \$29,142.75 is hereby accepted and ratified. A copy of the contract and bid tabulation sheet are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.


SECTION 2. Funding will not be expended by this ordinance. The approval of the contract specified in this ordinance is expressly contingent upon appropriation of funds.
