

AN ORDINANCE 9 6 9 4 8

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,984,206.00 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE OPERATION OF THE HEAD START-EARLY CHILD CARE PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD FEBRUARY 1, 2002 THROUGH JANUARY 31, 2003; AUTHORIZING THE CARRY FORWARD OF PRIOR YEAR UNOBLIGATED FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$485,345.00 FOR THE OPERATION OF THE HEAD START-EARLY CHILD CARE PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD FEBRUARY 1, 2002 THROUGH JANUARY 31, 2003; ADOPTING A REVISED HEAD START PROGRAM BUDGET REFLECTING SAID ACTIONS; ADOPTING A REVISED PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT AMENDMENT WITH PARENT/CHILD, INCORPORATED, OPERATOR OF SAID PROGRAM.

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WHEREAS, on January 31, 2002, pursuant to Ordinance No. 95248, the City Council authorized the acceptance of a continuation grant from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) for the operation of the San Antonio/Bexar County Head Start – Early Child Care Program, for the period February 1, 2002 to January 31, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), has issued Contract Amendment 2 awarding supplemental funds in the amount of \$1,984,206.00 and authorizing the carry forward of unobligated funds in the amount \$485,345.00 from the previous year’s contract for a Cost of Living Adjustment, quality improvement enhancements and funding for repairs due to flood damage; and

WHEREAS, the Head Start grant currently allows the program to provide a wide range of educational and social services to 6,789 pre-school children and their families; including: educational, health, mental health and disabilities services at the centers and at specific service provider sites; nutrition services; and parent involvement activities at home and at the centers. These services will be provided at 82 child development centers throughout San Antonio and Bexar County to children ranging from three to five years of age; and

WHEREAS, the City presently subcontracts with Parent/Child, Incorporated to operate the Head Start Program and the awarded funds are to continue the current operations and quality of said program; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize acceptance of awarded and carry forward funds in connection therewith, adopt a revised budget and personnel complement, and authorize the execution of a contract amendment with Parent Child, Inc. for operation of said program; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to accept the supplemental grant award in the amount of \$1,984,206.00 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) in support of the operation of the 2002 Head Start-Early Child Care Program for the twelve-month period beginning February 1, 2002. A copy of the award is attached hereto and incorporated herein as for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to carry forward an unobligated fund balance in the amount of \$485,345.00 from the 2001 grant from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services in support of the operation of the 2002 Head Start-Early Child Care Program for the twelve-month period beginning February 1, 2002.

SECTION 3. The revised budget for Project 26-022086 entitled "Head Start – Early Child Care Program 2002", and the revised personnel complement, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment II and III respectively, is hereby adopted for said program year beginning February 1, 2002 and ending January 31, 2003.

SECTION 4. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract amendment with Parent/Child Incorporated to increase the amount of funding to a total of \$44,782,356.00 for the 2002 Head Start-Early Child Care Program. A copy of the contract amendment, in substantially complete form, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment IV.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance will become effective on the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.
