

AN ORDINANCE **9 6 9 3 1**

**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$63,910.00 TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, WHICH, IF AWARDED, WILL FUND THE SECOND YEAR OF PROJECT EASE IN THE VICTIMS ADVOCACY SECTION.**

**WHEREAS**, \$63,910.00 in grant funds are available from the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, for funding of the second year of Project EASE of the Victims Advocacy Section of the San Antonio Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, Project EASE will utilize professional contractors, supervised and administered by current Victims Advocacy Section staff, to provide services to victims of violent crime that are deaf; and

**WHEREAS**, if awarded, the grant funds will also be used for the purchase of office and project supplies, training for project personnel and support of existing computer equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, an award of these grant funds would require an in-kind matching contribution of \$23,860.00 through existing staff time and volunteer hours; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or her designated representative, is hereby authorized to submit a grant application in the amount of \$63,910.00 to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, for funding of Project EASE of the Victims Advocacy Section of the San Antonio Police Department. A copy of the grant application shall be kept in the Office of the Chief of Police.

**SECTION 2.** Existing staff time and volunteer hours provided will be considered as an In-Kind Match of \$23,860.00.

**SECTION 3.** Funding will be accomplished by way of a subsequent Ordinance should the grant funds be awarded.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
