

AN ORDINANCE      **9 6 9 5 9**

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH THE ALAMO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT (“ACCD”) AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$12,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 3 HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUND, \$2,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 4 HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUND, \$2,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 5 HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUND, \$2,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 6 HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUND, \$2,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 7 HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUND, \$2,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 8 HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUND, \$2,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 9 HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUND, AND \$2,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 10 HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUND PAYABLE TO ALAMO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF A NEWLY CREATED BIOSCIENCE TECHNOLOGY COMPONENT TO BE ADDED TO THE ALAMO AREA AEROSPACE ACADEMY (“AAAA”) AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND SECURITY ACADEMY (“ITSA”) PROGRAM TO BE CONDUCTED IN THE SUMMER OF 2003; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILWOMAN ANTONIETTE MOORHOUSE, DISTRICT 3.

**WHEREAS**, City Council concurrence has been requested for the expenditure of \$12,000.00 from District 3 Human Development Services Fund, \$2,000.00 from District 4 Human Development Services Fund, \$2,000.00 from District 5 Human Development Services Fund provided that the funds are used for the benefit of District 5 participants, \$1,000.00 from District 6 Human Development Services Fund, \$2,000.00 from District 7 Human Development Services Fund, \$2,000.00 from District 8 Human Development Services Fund, and \$2,000.00 from District 9 Human Development Services Fund respectively from Councilwoman Antoniette Moorhouse, Councilman Enrique “Kike” Martin, Councilman David Garcia, Councilman Enrique Barrera, Councilman Julian Castro, Councilwoman Bonnie Conner, Councilman Carroll Schubert, and Councilman David Carpenter made payable to the Alamo Community College District for the administration of a newly created bioscience technology component to be added to the Alamo Area Aerospace Academy (“AAAA”) and Information Technology and Security Academy (“ITSA”) to be conducted in the Summer of 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of AAAA and ITSA is to harness local talent and direct San Antonio students to highly skilled careers in aerospace, avionics, information technology, information security; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The requests of District 3 Councilwoman Antoniette Moorhouse, District 4 Councilman Enrique “Kike” Martin, District 5 Councilman David Garcia, District 6 Councilman Enrique Barrera, District 7 Councilman Julian Castro, District 8 Councilwoman Bonnie Conner, and District 9 Councilman Carroll W. Schubert for reimbursement from their respective Human Development Services Fund in the total amounts as described in Section 2 of this Ordinance to the Alamo Community College District for the administration of a newly created bioscience technology component to be added to the Alamo Area Aerospace Academy (“AAAA”) and Information Technology and Security Academy (“ITSA”) to be conducted in the Summer of 2003 is hereby approved. **SECTION 2.** Funds in the amount of \$25,000.00 are authorized for encumbrance in Fund 11-000000 (General Fund) in the Index Codes specified below and are made payable to the Alamo Community College District.



**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth day after the passage hereof.


