

AN ORDINANCE **97145**

ACCEPTING THE OFFER SUBMITTED BY VISUAL INNOVATIONS COMPANY, INC. (WBE), A QUALIFIED INFORMATION SYSTEMS VENDOR, TO INSTALL AUDIOVISUAL EQUIPMENT FOR THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO'S INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR A TOTAL SUM OF \$39,499.00.

WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Visual Innovations Company, Inc. (WBE), to install audiovisual equipment for the City of San Antonio's International Center for a total sum of \$39,499.00; and

WHEREAS, this contract will provide audiovisual equipment which will help increase the number of special events booked and will be utilized by the tenants, City departments and other entities reserving the conference rooms or gallery space for special events; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the Department of Asset Management will charge a rental fee for the use of the audiovisual equipment, generating additional revenue; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the State of Texas Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Resolution No. 91-39-53 on September 12, 1991; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from Visual Innovations Company, Inc. (WBE), at a total sum of \$39,499.00, to install audiovisual equipment for the City of San Antonio's International Center is hereby accepted. A copy of the bid and bid tabulation sheet is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. Funds are authorized to be encumbered in Fund 29-0025000 (Miscellaneous Special Revenue), in Index Code 626218 entitled "Mach. & Equip -Other" when a purchase order in the amount of \$39,499.00 is issued and made payable to Visual Innovations.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
