

AN ORDINANCE **97175**

ACCEPTING THE BID FROM TEXAS HIGHWAY PRODUCTS, LTD., UTILIZING THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT, TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT WITH VIDEO IMAGE VEHICLE DETECTION SYSTEMS FOR A TOTAL SUM OF \$98,011.50.

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WHEREAS, a bid was submitted by Texas Highway Products Ltd. to provide the Public Works Department with video image vehicle detection systems for a total sum of \$98,011.50; and

WHEREAS, this contract will provide video image vehicle detection systems for the purpose of detecting the presence of vehicles at signalized intersections throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, this equipment will be purchased utilizing the Texas Department of Transportation contract number 30144-3-459-D and this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the State of Texas Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Resolution No. 91-39-53 on September 12, 1991; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bid of Texas Highway Products, Ltd. in the amount of \$98,011.50 to provide the Public Works Department with video image vehicle detection systems is hereby accepted. A copy of the bid tabulation sheet is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. Funds are authorized to be encumbered in Fund 40-0020050 (Other Capital Projects- Public Works) in the index codes indicated below when a purchase order in the amount of \$98,010.00 is issued and made payable to Texas Highway Products Ltd. to purchase traffic control cameras.


