

AN ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MAIN STREET BETWEEN COMMERCE AND DOLOROSA/MARKET STREETS ON SUNDAY, MARCH 9, 2003 FROM 6:00 A.M. UNTIL 4:00 P.M. IN CONNECTION WITH THE CELEBRATION OF THE 273<sup>RD</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE FOUNDING OF THE VILLA DE SAN FERNANDO; SPONSORED BY THE FRIENDS OF THE CANARY ISLANDS – SAN ANTONIO, INC.**

**WHEREAS**, the Friends of the Canary Islands-San Antonio, Inc. has requested the temporary closure of Main Street between Commerce and Dolorosa (Market) Streets on Sunday, March 9, 2003 from 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. for the Celebration of the 273<sup>rd</sup> Anniversary of the founding of the Villa de San Fernando; and

**WHEREAS**, the request for the temporary closure of this street has been evaluated and it has been found that no adverse traffic problems would result, and that the request should be granted in accordance with the City's usual practice and procedure for temporary closures; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance is consistent with the City policy requiring an Ordinance where closures of public streets are requested; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby authorizes the temporary closure of Main Street between Commerce and Dolorosa (Market) Streets on Sunday, March 9, 2003 from 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in order for the Friends of the Canary Islands-San Antonio, Inc. to hold the 273<sup>rd</sup> Anniversary of the founding of the Villa de San Fernando.

**SECTION 2.** The Friends of the Canary Islands-San Antonio, Inc. shall be responsible for a) all insurance requirements, b) obtaining the required closure permit fee, and any other fees and licenses charges, c) posting signs, barricades, and off-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the

safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic and d) cleaning up after the event is held.

**SECTION 3.** The Friends of the Canary Islands-San Antonio, Inc. shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street rights of way.

**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall be effective on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March, 2003.




