AN ORDINANCE **97073**

**AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 96931, PASSED AND APPROVED ON DECEMBER 19, 2002, WHICH SUBMITTED A \$63,910.00 GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, BY SPECIFYING THE GRANT'S AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL, REDUCING AND SPECIFYING THE CITY MATCH, AND INCLUDING NEW LANGUAGE AS REQUIRED BY THE TEXAS ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, SUBCHAPTER D, SECTION 3.2021.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 96931, passed and approved on December 19, 2002, authorized the City Manager or her designated representative, to submit a grant application in the amount of \$63,910.00 to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, for funding of the second year of Project EASE of the Victims Advocacy Section of the San Antonio Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division (CJD) now requires specific naming of the authorized grant official, specific delineation of the type of match being provided, specific language authorizing the submission of the grant application, and assurance that in the event of loss or misuse of grant funds, the governing body will return all funds to CJD, as required by Section 3.2021 of the Texas Administrative Code; and

**WHEREAS**, Deputy City Manager J. Rolando Bono will serve as the city official designed to be the authorized grant official; and

**WHEREAS**, an award of these grant funds would require a matching contribution of \$15,955.00, consisting of \$15,155.00 in matching contributions based on a percentage of time of existing City staff and \$800.00 in volunteer hours; and

**WHEREAS**, in the event of loss or misuse of CJD funds, the City of San Antonio will return all funds to CJD; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Deputy City Manager J. Rolando Bono is hereby authorized to submit a grant application in the amount of \$63,910.00 to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, for funding of Project EASE of the Victims Advocacy Section of the San Antonio Police Department. Mr. Bono is hereby designated the authorized grant official. A copy of the grant application shall be kept in the Office of the Chief of Police.

**SECTION 2.** An award of these grant funds would require a matching contribution of \$15,955.00, consisting of \$15,155.00 in matching contributions based on a percentage of time of existing City staff and \$800.00 in volunteer hours.

**SECTION 3.** In the event of loss or misuse of CJD funds, the City of San Antonio will return all funds to CJD.


**SECTION 4.** Ordinance 96931, passed and approved on December 19, 2002, is hereby amended as reflected herein.


**SECTION 5.** Funding will be accomplished by way of a subsequent ordinance should the grant funds be awarded.
