

AN ORDINANCE **97262**

ESTABLISHING THE CONVENTION CENTER HOTEL ADVISORY BOARD (CCHAB) TO ASSIST THE CITY COUNCIL IN FORMULATING RECOMMENDATIONS AND FOCUS ON EXPEDITING THE HOTEL DEVELOPMENT PROCESS.

**WHEREAS**, as part of the City's ongoing efforts to secure a Convention Center Headquarters Hotel (the "Project") adjacent to the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center, a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) was issued on July 31, 2002 seeking a firm who would develop and construct the Project, which solicitation resulted in five (5) responses; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council desires to establish a Convention Center Hotel Advisory Board to be composed of local experts to assist the City Council by undertaking the various phases of analysis related to these responses and formulating overall recommendations for the eventual development of the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council further desires that membership on this Board represent various sectors of expertise; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** There is hereby created a Convention Center Hotel Advisory Board to consist of the following categories of membership:

Three (3) members from the Finance/Banking Sector;

Three (3) members from the Real Estate/Corporate Sector, including one (1) from the Hotel/Tourism Industry Industry; and

One (1) from the Community Sector

Members shall serve four-year staggered terms and shall be appointed by City Council pursuant to the adoption of a future City Ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.
