

AN ORDINANCE **97678**

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A JOINT USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AND THE SAN ANTONIO WATER SYSTEM (SAWS) IN CONNECTION WITH THE SALADO CREEK HIKE & BIKE PHASE I PROJECT, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 2.

WHEREAS, San Antonio Water System (SAWS) has requested permission to use approximately 0.577 acres of land owned by the City of San Antonio to construct SAWS project number 01-8619-215 known as the Aquifer Storage and Recovery Water Integration Program Transmission Main, Segment IV in connection with the Salado Creek Hike & Bike Phase I Project; and

WHEREAS, the property is located on Gembler Road adjacent to Salado Creek between Kono and Currency Roads; and

WHEREAS, this project includes constructing a hike and bike trail from Willow Springs Golf Course to Comanche Park; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance is consistent with City policy in regulating the use of public land under the control of the City of San Antonio, **NOW THEREFORE;**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute a Joint Use Agreement between the City of San Antonio and San Antonio Water System to use approximately 0.577 acres of land owned by the City of San Antonio located on Gembler Road adjacent to Salado Creek between Kono and Currency Roads for the purpose of constructing the Aquifer Storage and Recovery Water Integration Program Transmission Main, Segment IV. A copy of the Joint Use Agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective on the 8th day of June 2003.
