

AN ORDINANCE **97699**

APPOINTING ROSS A. RODRIGUEZ AS A PART-TIME MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE TO SERVE THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF OFFICE ENDING AUGUST 31, 2003 OF FORMER JUDGE DAVID J. RODRIGUEZ AS REQUESTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL QUALITY OF LIFE SUBCOMMITTEE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE UPON PASSAGE BY EIGHT (8) AFFIRMATIVE VOTES.

WHEREAS, the Quality of Life Subcommittee met on Monday, May 5, 2003 to review applications for those individuals seeking appointments and to interview candidates for the part-time Municipal Court Judge position presently vacant due to the resignation of Judge David J. Rodriguez; and

WHEREAS, after careful review of applications, the Committee selected two applicants for interview after which the consensus of the Committee was to recommend the appointment of Ross A. Rodriguez to fill the present vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now wishes to appoint Ross A. Rodriguez to fill the unexpired term of the Municipal Court Judge position presently vacant due to the resignation of Judge David J. Rodriguez such appointment to expire on August 31, 2003; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Ross A Rodriguez is hereby appointed as a part-time judge of Municipal Court to fill the unexpired term of the Municipal Court Judge position presently vacant due to the resignation of Judge David J. Rodriguez, such appointment to expire on August 31, 2003.


SECTION 2. This part-time appointment provides for all authority, compensation and benefits as the City Council has previously established and that current part-time judges of Municipal Court now hold and receive.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately if passed by at least eight (8) votes.
