

AN ORDINANCE **97141**

**AUTHORIZING THE TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$1,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 7 AND MAYOR'S CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FUNDS, PAYABLE TO THE MONTICELLO HISTORIC DISTRICT ORGANIZATION, TO BE USED TO OFFSET COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE ANNUAL FIESTA HOME TOUR TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, APRIL 19, 2003; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN JULIAN CASTRO.**

**WHEREAS**, Councilman Julian Castro, District 7, has requested Council concurrence for the expenditure of \$500.00 from the Council District 7 Contingency Fund to the Monticello Historic District Organization, to be used to offset costs associated with the annual Fiesta Home Tour to be held on Saturday, April 19, 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition, the Mayor (\$500.00) has requested Council concurrence for expenditure from his respective "Contingency Account" in the amount indicated, similarly to assist the Monticello Historic District Organization.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to authorize the expenditures as requested; **NOW THEREFORE**;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The request of Councilman Julian Castro, District 7, for reimbursement from the District 7 Contingency Account in the total amount of \$500.00 to Monticello Historic District Organization is hereby approved and authorized. A copy of Councilman Castro's request is set out in Attachment I.

**SECTION 2.** The total amount of \$1,000.00 is authorized to be encumbered for payment from the following Contingency Accounts and is made payable to Monticello Historic District Organization:

Index Code 603613 entitled "District 7 Contingency Fund"	\$500.00

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**SECTION 3.** The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Monticello Historic District Organization in the amount of \$1,000.00 to be used to offset costs associated with the annual Fiesta Home Tour. A copy of the "Agreement to Use Funds of the City of San Antonio" is attached hereto and appearing in substantially the same form as Attachment II.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) day after the passage hereof.


