

AN ORDINANCE **97433**

NAMING A TRAILHEAD LOCATED WITHIN THE LEON CREEK GREENWAY ON BABCOCK ROAD IN CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 THE "BUDDY CALK TRAILHEAD."

WHEREAS, Councilwoman Bonnie Conner submitted a request to name the City's trailhead located within the Leon Creek Greenway located at Babcock Road and which leads to the Earl Scott Memorial Pond within City Council District 8, currently unnamed, to "Buddy Calk Trailhead" in honor of Mr. Buddy Calk; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Buddy Calk was local community leader who was dedicated to the preservation of Leon Creek, and who actively participated in City government by serving on the Transportation Advisory Board and by speaking publicly to the City Council on matters that affected Leon Creek and the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, as per the requirements of Chapter 2, Article VI of the City Code of the City of San Antonio Councilwoman Bonnie Conner appointed a committee to hold a public hearing on this request and obtain comments from the public and any other recommendations for the name of this public facility; and

WHEREAS, after notice of said proposal was disseminated through public service announcements and media release, there were no comments or letters received regarding the proposed name; and

WHEREAS, the committee held a public hearing on March 24, 2003 in which there was comment from the residents who attended, all of whom were in favor of the name to honor Mr. Calk; and

WHEREAS, after receiving comments from the public, the committee voted to recommend the naming of the trailhead to "Buddy Calk Trailhead"; and

WHEREAS, all of the requirements of Chapter 2, Article VI of the City Code of the City of San Antonio having been met; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


Section 1. The City of San Antonio's trailhead located within the Leon Creek Greenway located at Babcock Road and which leads to the Earl Scott Memorial Pond within City Council District 8, currently unnamed, is hereby named the "Buddy Calk Trailhead." City staff is hereby directed to provide appropriate signage to this effect.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.
