

AN ORDINANCE **97434**

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000.00 FROM COURTESY ASSOCIATES AT THE REQUEST OF THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SCIENCES (NIEHS) TO SUPPORT THE COMMUNITY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAM OF THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT (SAMHD) DURING THE PERIOD FEBRUARY 20, 2003 THROUGH FEBRUARY 19, 2004; ESTABLISHING A FUND; ADOPTING A BUDGET; AND AUTHORIZING RELATED PAYMENTS.

WHEREAS, the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) obtained the professional services of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) to conduct activities developed under a cooperative agreement with the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) entitled Environmental Health Education Needs Assessment Project in reference to the Kelly Air Force Base site; and

WHEREAS, the SAMHD provided the professional services to conduct an environmental health education needs assessment of the community surrounding the former Kelly Air Force Base through funding received from NACCHO for the period July 12, 2001 through August 12, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences (NIEHS), through their accounting representative Courtesy Associates, desires to complement this effort by funding community environmental education poster contests in the schools located in the neighborhoods surrounding Kelly AFB and in schools in the Northeast and Northwest parts of San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize the acceptance of the cash grant, establish a fund, adopt a budget and authorize related payments; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to accept a grant of \$15,000.00 to support the Community Environmental Education Program that will complement the National Association of City and County Health Officials (NACCHO) Project of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) during the period February 20, 2003 through February 19, 2004. A copy of the award letter and check is set out in Attachment II and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The account entitled "NIEHS Environmental Health Education Project", Fund No. 26-022096 has been designated for use in accounting for the fiscal transactions of this project.

SECTION 3. The sum of \$15,000.00 is appropriated in the above fund for the NIEHS Environmental Health Education Project and the budget set out in Attachment I is approved and adopted for entry on the City books.

SECTION 4. Payments in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$3,000.00 are hereby authorized to be paid from Fund No. 26-022096, Activity Code 36-06-78, Index Code 761064 to cover various sponsorship fees for the community environmental education poster contests held in collaboration with Kelly AFB.


SECTION 5. Payments in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$4,000.00 are hereby authorized to be paid from Fund No. 26-022096, Activity Code 36-06-78, Index Code 761106 to cover various gift awards for the community environmental education poster contest competition winners.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth day after passage hereof.
