

AN ORDINANCE **9 7 4 3 6**

APPROVING A PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR WOODLAWN LAKE IN CONNECTION WITH THE EARTH DAY 5K FUN RUN TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, APRIL 19, 2003 FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 8:30 A.M.

WHEREAS, the **San Antonio** has applied for a parade permit to hold the “Earth Day 5K Fun Run” on Saturday, April 19, 2003 beginning at 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, for this event to take place, it will be necessary to temporarily close certain streets near Woodlawn Lake, as stated in the route in “Section 2” below; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that granting the request will promote the health, safety and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity; and

WHEREAS, the request has been evaluated and it has been found that no adverse traffic problems would result, and that the request should be granted in accordance with the City’s usual practice and procedure; **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the requested parade permit to the **San Antonio** so that it may hold the “Earth Day 5K Fun Run” on Saturday, April 19, 2003 beginning at 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 a.m.

SECTION 2. In order to hold “Earth Day 5K Fun Run” on Saturday, April 19, 2003 beginning at 7:00 a.m. until 8:30 a.m., the temporary closure of certain streets near Woodlawn Lake as listed in the route below to vehicular traffic is hereby authorized:

- Assembly Area:** Woodlawn Lake parking lot
Route: North on Josephine Tobin to Woodlawn (one lane only),
East on the running track before Woodlawn Avenue,
Remainder of the run will be on the running tract on park property.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

SECTION 4. **San Antonio** shall be responsible for the following:

- a) paying the required street closure permit fee and any fees and license charges,
- b) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio’s Public Works and/or Police

- Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and
- c) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective on the 13th day of April, otherwise, it shall be effective on April 20, 2003.
