

AN ORDINANCE **97458**

RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL AND TECHNICAL SUBMISSIONS TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING & URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) IN CONNECTION WITH THE 2002 CONTINUUM OF CARE HOMELESS ASSISTANCE SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROGRAM (SHP); AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A MULTI-YEAR GRANT IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$4,533,729.00 IN CONNECTION WITH SAID PROPOSAL; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF GRANT AGREEMENTS WITH HUD FOR SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED BY VARIOUS AGENCIES.

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WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) announced the availability of funding under its 2002 Continuum of Care Homeless Assistance Supportive Housing Program; and

WHEREAS, said funds were conditionally awarded based on the community's Continuum of Care strategy to address the needs for housing and services for homeless persons; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to ratify the submission of a proposal and technical submissions, authorize the acceptance of the award, and authorize the execution of twelve grant agreements with HUD; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City's submission of the 2002 Supportive Housing Program (SHP) proposal and technical submissions to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in connection with the 2002 Continuum of Care Homeless Assistance Supportive Housing Program is hereby ratified. A copy of such proposal and technical submissions are on file in the Department of Community Initiatives, Community Action Division.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to accept a multi-year grant in an amount up to \$4,533,729.00 from HUD for the 2002 Supportive Housing Program. The City Manager or her designee, is further authorized to execute twelve grant agreements with HUD in connection therewith and to execute such certifications and assurances as the granting agency requires. A copy of the standard grant agreement for **Renewals** of existing grants, in substantially final form, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment II. A copy of the standard grant agreement for **New** grants, in substantially final form, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment III. The grant agreements will provide funding for the following Service Providers in an amount up to the amount listed:




