

AN ORDINANCE

**APPROVING A PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS IN CONNECTION WITH THE POLICE OFFICER MEMORIAL RUN TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 24, 2003 FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 11:00 A.M.; SPONSORED BY THE RUN AWAY STORE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Run Away Store has applied for a parade permit to hold the “Police Officer Memorial Run” on Saturday, May 24, 2003 beginning at 7:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. and in order for this event to take place, it will be necessary to temporarily close certain streets near Brackenridge Park, as stated in the route in “Section 2” below; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that granting the request will promote the health, safety and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity; and

**WHEREAS**, the request has been evaluated and it has been found that no adverse traffic problems would result, and that the request should be granted in accordance with the City’s usual practice and procedure; **NOW THEREFORE**;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby approves the requested parade permit to the Run Away Store so that it may hold the “Police Officer Memorial Run” on Saturday, May 24, 2003 beginning at 7:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m.

**SECTION 2.** In order to hold “Police Officer Memorial Run” on Saturday, May 24, 2003 beginning at 7:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m., the temporary closure of certain streets near Brackenridge Park as listed in the route below to vehicular traffic is hereby authorized:

**Assembly Area:** Avenue B between Josephine and Pearl Parkway  
**Route:** North on Avenue B to Tuleta, (turn around)  
South on Avenue B to Josephine,

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

**SECTION 4.** The Run Away Store shall be responsible for the following:

- a) paying the required street closure permit fee and any fees and license charges,
- b) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio’s Public Works and/or Police Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and

c) cleaning the area up after the event is held.


**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall be effective on the 27th day of April 2003.


