

AN ORDINANCE

97816

AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR TEXAS BLOCK GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$3,223,161.00 FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) IN SUPPORT OF VARIOUS AIRPORT IMPROVEMENTS AT STINSON MUNICIPAL AIRPORT; COMMITTING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COST OF THESE IMPROVEMENTS IN THE AMOUNT OF TEN PERCENT (10%), NOT TO EXCEED \$358,129.00; AND DESIGNATING TXDOT AS THE CITY'S AGENT FOR PURPOSES OF THIS GRANT.

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WHEREAS, the City has in its Five Year Capital Program airfield projects to improve runways, taxiways and navigational aids at Stinson Municipal Airport (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio seeks to request financial assistance from the Texas Department Of Transportation (TxDOT) for construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the total Project costs are estimated to be \$358,129.00 of which the City's matching share is estimated to be \$358,129.00; and

WHEREAS, as a condition of accepting this grant, if offered, the City names TxDOT as its agent for the purposes of applying for, receiving and disbursing all funds for these improvements, for the selection of consultants, and for the administration of contracts necessary for the implementation of these improvements; and

WHEREAS, in order to initiate this Project, it is now necessary to authorize the application for the grant to include intent to complete airfield projects, commit to City's matching share and designating TxDOT as its agent in matters relating to this grant; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to make formal application to the Texas Department of Transportation for a Texas Block Grant in the estimated amount \$3,223,161.00.

SECTION 2. The City of San Antonio, as a condition of accepting the grant if and when offered, agrees to construct and improve the improve runways, taxiways and navigational aids at Stinson Municipal Airport as identified in the Five Year Capital Program and to participate in the amount of 10% of the total Project costs not to exceed \$358,129.00.

SECTION 3. The City of San Antonio names the Texas Department of Transportation as its agent for the purposes of applying for, receiving and disbursing all funds for these improvements, for the selection of consultants, and for the administration of contracts necessary for the implementation of these improvements.


SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This will become effective on the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.
