

AN ORDINANCE **97409**

**AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A DONATION
OF OFFICE FURNITURE FROM THE SAN ANTONIO
LOCAL DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, INC., A 501(C)(3)
ORGANIZATION, TO THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO.**

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Local Development Company, Inc. (“SALDC”) is a local non-profit 501(c)(3) development company that is now financially independent from the City of San Antonio (“City”), operating from its own revenues and through a grant from the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA), but is provided staff and resource support by the City in furtherance of SALDC’s shared goals of contributing to the development of small businesses, industrial job development and commercial revitalization; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2003, SALDC will move from the offices leased to, and provided by, the City in the Washington Place Office Building at 215 S. San Saba to the City-owned Business Development Services Center at 1901 S. Alamo Street; and

WHEREAS, the City will provide office furniture for SALDC at this new location except for file cabinets which SALDC will retain from the Washington Place Office Building; and

WHEREAS, SALDC’s existing office furniture, acquired over a period of 22 years at a total cost of \$9,811.38, is fully depreciated or expensed and no longer carries a net book value; and

WHEREAS, the expense to SALDC to store this unneeded furniture is impractical due to its depreciated value, but is in good condition and functional for use in various City departments that must otherwise purchase furnishings at significant cost; and

WHEREAS, City Council finds that authorizing the donation of SALDC’s former furnishings is in the best interest of the City and is consistent with City policy of maximizing use of existing resources; **NOW THEREFORE:**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, to accept a donation of fully depreciated office furniture from the San Antonio Local Development Company, Inc., a 501(c)(3) organization, to the City of San Antonio, a schedule of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.
