

AN ORDINANCE **97606**

ACCEPTING THE LOW BIDS SUBMITTED BY SCHOOL SPECIALTY, LEARNING ZONE, CANNON SPORTS, INC., DIRECT ADVANTAGE, S & S WORLDWIDE, AND COLLEGIATE PACIFIC, TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT WITH GAMES FOR THE AFTER SCHOOL CHALLENGE AND SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAMS FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$64,002.48.

WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Parks & Recreation Department with games for the after school challenge and summer recreation programs; and

WHEREAS, the low bids were submitted by School Specialty, Learning Zone, Cannon Sports, Inc., Direct Advantage, S & S Worldwide, and Collegiate Pacific for a total amount of \$64,002.48; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The low bids submitted by School Specialty, Learning Zone, Cannon Sports, Inc., Direct Advantage, S & S Worldwide, and Collegiate Pacific to provide the City of San Antonio Parks & Recreation Department with games for the after school challenge and summer recreation programs for a total amount of \$64,002.48 are hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the deposit by the successful bidder of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. Attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A are the bids and bid tabulation sheets.

SECTION 2. Funds are authorized to be encumbered in Fund 11-000000 (General Fund) in the Index Codes specified below when purchase orders are issued and made payable to School Specialty, Learning Zone, Cannon Sports, Inc., Direct Advantage, S&S Worldwide, and Collegiate Pacific.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.


