

AN ORDINANCE **97628**

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE SECOND AMENDMENT OF THE PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE ALAMO WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT AREA (CITY OF SAN ANTONIO, BEXAR COUNTY AND THE AREA RURAL JUDGES) AND THE ALAMO WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD TO CLARIFY THEIR ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES, RELATIONSHIPS AND FUNCTIONS WITH REGARD TO WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT AND RELATED ISSUES.

WHEREAS, State and Federal law requires a partnership agreement between the City of San Antonio, Bexar County and the eleven area rural judges (“Chief Elected Officials”) and the Alamo Workforce Development Board (“AWDB”); and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 86594, passed and approved on September 11, 1997, authorized a Partnership Agreement between the Chief Elected Officials and the AWDB (“Partnership Agreement”) to define their roles, responsibilities, relationships and functions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 87588, passed and approved on March 26, 1998, the Partnership Agreement was amended to increase the maximum number of board members on the AWDB from 29 to 30 members; and

WHEREAS, it is now the desire of the Chief Elected Officials and the AWDB to execute a second amendment to the Partnership Agreement to clarify their roles, responsibilities, relationships and functions; and

WHEREAS, this second amendment to the Partnership Agreement has been approved by the Area Rural Judges and by the AWDB; and

WHEREAS, this second amendment to the Partnership Agreement was reviewed by the Economic and Human Development Committee on May 14, 2003; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The second amendment of the Partnership Agreement between the Chief Elected Officials of the Alamo Workforce Development Area (City of San Antonio, Bexar County and the Area Rural Judges) and the Alamo Workforce Development Board clarifying the roles, responsibilities, relationships and functions of these parties with regard to workforce development and related issues is hereby authorized. A copy of such amendment is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment I. The Mayor, as the Chief Elected Official of the City of San Antonio, is authorized to sign said Second Amendment of the Partnership Agreement and to make appointments set forth in Article IV D of said agreement.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.
