

AN ORDINANCE **97746**

AUTHORIZING THE TOTAL EXPENDITURE OF \$750.00 FROM VARIOUS CITY COUNCIL CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FUNDS TO THE EDGEWOOD SEMINOLES TO BE USED TO PURCHASE UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT FOR THE FOOTBALL AND CHEERLEADING TEAMS; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN ENRIQUE M. BARRERA.

WHEREAS, Councilman Enrique M. Barrera has requested Council concurrence for the expenditure of \$500.00 from the District 6 Contingency Account Fund to the Edgewood Seminoles to be used to purchase uniforms and equipment for the football and cheerleading teams;

WHEREAS, in addition, Councilman Ron Segovia, District 3 has requested Council concurrence for expenditure of \$250.00 from his respective "District 3 Contingency Account Fund" in the amount indicated, similarly to assist the Edgewood Seminoles; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to authorize the expenditure as requested by Councilman Enrique M. Barrera, **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The request of Councilman Enrique M. Barrera, City Councilman of District 6, for reimbursement from the District 6 Contingency Budget Account in the total amount of \$500.00 to the Edgewood Seminoles to purchase uniforms and equipment for the football and cheerleading teams is hereby approved and authorized. A copy of Councilman Barrera's request is set out in Attachment 1 hereof.

SECTION 2. The total amount of \$750.00 is encumbered for payment from the following Contingency Budget Accounts and is made payable to the Edgewood Seminoles:

Index Code 603597 entitled "District 6 Contingency Fund"	<i>\$500.00</i>
Index Code 603506 entitled "District 3 Contingency Fund"	<u>\$250.00</u>
TOTAL	\$750.00

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to transfer from the District 6 Contingency Account Fund \$500.00 and from the District 3 Contingency Account Fund the amount of \$250.00 to the Edgewood Seminoles to be for these purposes and to execute a contract with them setting out certain terms and conditions.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth (10th) day after the passage hereof.


