

AN ORDINANCE

97821

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF \$120,341.00 FROM THE SAN ANTONIO WATER SYSTEM (SYSTEM) BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO ADMINISTER THE WATER METER DISCOUNT AFFORDABILITY PROGRAM (WMDAP) FOR 2003; ESTABLISHING A BUDGET; AND APPROVING A PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the City established and continued the Water Meter Discount Affordability Program (WMDAP) through Ordinances No. 92752 and No. 93597 dated October 19, 2000 and March 15, 2001, respectively, allowing low-income System ratepayers to receive a 50% discount on their monthly water meter charge when certified as eligible for the program by the City's Department of Community Initiatives, Community Action Division (CAD) staff; and

WHEREAS, the City and the System have agreed to continue to implement the WMDAP in 2003 under the terms of the existing WMDAP Interjurisdictional Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the System has agreed to pay the City \$120,341.00 for the purpose of implementing the WMDAP in 2003; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee is authorized to accept of \$120,341.00 from the San Antonio Water System (System) Board of Trustees to administer the Water Meter Discount Affordability Program (WMDAP) in 2003 in accordance with the WMDAP Interjurisdictional Agreement. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **ATTACHMENT I**.

SECTION 2. Fund No. 26-012194 entitled "SAWS Water Meter Discount Program" is hereby designated for use in accounting of said program.

SECTION 3. The 2003 WMDAP Budget and Personnel Complement, attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **ATTACHMENT II** and **III**, respectively, are hereby approved.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.
