AN ORDINANCE

APPROVING AN EXTENSION OF LINE-OF-DUTY LEAVE FOR FIRE APPARATUS OPERATOR HENRY F. KEIL, JR. AND RESTORING ONE THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-TWO (1272) HOURS, OR FIFTY-THREE (53) SHIFTS, OF HIS SICK LEAVE, AND ALLOWING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO CONSIDER THAT PERIOD AS LINE-OF-DUTY LEAVE.

WHEREAS, section 143.073 of the Texas Local Government Code provides that a firefighter injured in the line of duty is entitled to line-of-duty injury leave with full pay for a period commensurate with the injury and not to exceed one year; and

WHEREAS, section 143.073 also provides that a municipality's governing body may extend the line-of-duty injury leave beyond one year; and

WHEREAS, San Antonio Fire Department Fire Apparatus Operator Henry F. Keil, Jr. injured his back in the line of duty on January 5, 2001; and

WHEREAS, FAO Keil has returned to full duty; and

WHEREAS, FAO Keil is requesting an extension of line-of-duty injury leave for the period January 6, 2002, to July 2, 2002; and

WHEREAS, approving the requested extension would restore fifty-three shifts (1272 hours) of his sick leave to FAO Keil; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. An extension beyond one year of Fire Apparatus Operator Henry F. Keil, Jr.'s line-of-duty injury leave for the period January 6, 2002, to July 2, 2002, and the restoration of fifty-three shifts (1272 hours) of personal leave to FAO Keil are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
