

AN ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF SAMMY G. NIETO TO THE ALAMO WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD (PRIVATE SECTOR LARGE/FOR PROFIT BUSINESS CATEGORY) FOR A TERM OF OFFICE TO EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31, 2005.

**WHEREAS**, the Partnership Agreement between the Chief Elected Officials and the Alamo Workforce Development Inc. specifies that the Chief Elected Officials shall reach consensus upon a single slate of individuals recommended for appointment to the Alamo Workforce Development Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the above mentioned agreement states that no appointment to the Board will be official until it is approved by the City of San Antonio, Bexar County and the Area Judges, representing the surrounding eleven (11) rural counties; and

**WHEREAS**, Sammy G. Nieto has been selected to fill a vacancy as a result of a resignation by a representative in the category of private sector large/for profit business; and

**WHEREAS**, representatives from the Committee of Six, including Councilman Enrique Barrera, Bexar County Commissioners Elizondo and Adkisson, Commissioner Millikin of Comal County, and Judge Evans of Bandera County selected the applicant from a pool of six nominations to serve an unexpired three-year term on the Alamo Workforce Development Board; **NOW THEREFORE:**


**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**


