

AN ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$1,000.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 2 CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FUND, PAYABLE TO THE JUNETEENTH FREEDOM COALITION, TO BE USED TO HELP OFFSET THE COST OF THE BARRICADES FOR THE JUNETEENTH PARADE THAT WAS HELD ON JUNE 14, 2003; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN JOEL WILLIAMS.**

**WHEREAS**, Councilman Joel Williams has requested Council concurrence for the expenditure of \$1,000.00 from the District 2 Contingency Account Fund to the Juneteenth Freedom Coalition to be used to help offset the cost of barricades for the Juneteenth Parade that was held on June 14, 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to authorize the expenditure as requested by Councilman Joel Williams, **NOW THEREFORE**;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The request of Councilman Joel Williams, City Councilman of District 2 for the funds to help offset the cost of the Juneteenth Parade that was held on June 14, 2003 from the District 2 Contingency Account Fund in the amount of \$1,000.00 is hereby approved and authorized. A copy of Councilman Williams' request is set out in Attachment I hereof.


**SECTION 2.** The expenditure of \$1,000.00 is authorized from the District 2 Contingency Account Fund, Index Code 603431, payable to the Juneteenth Freedom Coalition, to be used to help offset the cost of the barricades for the Juneteenth Parade that was held on June 14, 2003.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the Juneteenth Freedom Coalition for the use of the amount of \$1,000.00. A copy of the "Agreement to Use Funds of the City of San Antonio" is attached hereto and appearing in substantially the same form as Attachment II.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) day after the passage hereof.


