

AN ORDINANCE **96973**

**ACCEPTING THE LOW BID SUBMITTED BY INFOLAB, INC.  
TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO HEALTH  
DEPARTMENT WITH A CLINICAL CHEMISTRY ANALYZER  
FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$49,950.00.**

**WHEREAS**, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Health Department with a clinical chemistry analyzer; and

**WHEREAS**, the low bid was submitted by Infolab, Inc. for a total cost of \$49,950.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The low bid submitted by Infolab, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Health Department with a clinical chemistry analyzer for a total cost of \$49,950.00 is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the deposit by the successful bidder of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. Attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A is the bid and bid tabulation sheet.


**SECTION 2.** Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$49,950.00 will be from Fund No. 26-016052, Index Code 743252, and said amount will be encumbered when Purchasing issues the purchase requisition and payment is hereby authorized to Infolab, Inc.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
