

AN ORDINANCE                    **9 7 0 2 6**

**AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$2,500.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 10 CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FUND, PAYABLE TO THE NORTHSIDE NEIGHBORS ON PATROL, TO BE USED TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS FOR MANUALS, STUDY MATERIALS, PHOTO ID'S, SHIRTS, CAPS AND IDENTIFICATION DECALS; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN DAVID CARPENTER.**

**WHEREAS**, Councilman David Carpenter, District 10, has requested Council concurrence for the expenditure of \$2,500.00 from the Council District 10 Contingency Fund to the Northside Neighbors on Patrol to be used to help defray the costs for manuals, study materials, photo ID's, shirts, caps and identification decals; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to authorize the expenditure as requested by Councilman David Carpenter, **NOW THEREFORE**;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The request of Councilman David Carpenter, District 10, for payment from the District 10 Contingency Budget Account in the total amount of \$2,500.00 to the Northside Neighbors on Patrol, for the purpose set out above is hereby approved and authorized. A copy of Councilman Carpenter's request is set out in Attachment I.

**SECTION 2.** The amount of \$2,500.00 is encumbered for payment in the District 10 Contingency Budget Account, Index Code 603670 entitled "District 10 Contingency Fund," and is made payable to the Northside Neighbors on Patrol.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Northside Neighbors on Patrol in the amount of \$2,500.00 to help defray the costs associated with the Northside Neighbors on Patrol. A copy of the "Agreement to Use Funds of the City of San Antonio" is attached hereto and appearing in substantially the same form as Attachment II.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

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**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) day after the passage hereof.
