

AN ORDINANCE **97025**

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$500.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 9 CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FUND, PAYABLE TO THE INCARNATE WORD HIGH SCHOOL MADRIGAL SINGERS, TO BE USED TO OFFSET COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE MADRIGAL SINGERS' TRIP TO WASHINGTON, D.C. FROM DECEMBER 4, 2002 THROUGH DECEMBER 8, 2002 TO SING AT THE WHITE HOUSE; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN CARROLL W. SCHUBERT.

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WHEREAS, Councilman Carroll W. Schubert, District 9, has requested Council concurrence for the expenditure of \$500.00 from the Council District 9 Contingency Fund to be used to offset costs associated with the Madrigal Singers' trip to Washington, D.C. from December 4, 2002 through December 8, 2002 to sing at the White House; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to authorize the expenditure as requested by Councilman Carroll W. Schubert, **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The request of Councilman Carroll W. Schubert, District 9, for payment from the District 9 Contingency Budget Account in the total amount of \$500.00 to the Incarnate Word High School Madrigal Singers, for the purpose set out above is hereby approved and authorized. A copy of Councilman Schubert's request is set out in Attachment I.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$500.00 is encumbered for payment in the District 9 Contingency Budget Account, Index Code 603654 entitled "District 9 Contingency Fund," and is make payable to the Incarnate Word High School Madrigal Singers.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Incarnate Word High School Madrigal Singers in the amount of \$500.00 for costs set out above. A copy of the "Agreement to Use Funds of the City of San Antonio" is attached hereto and appearing in substantially the same form as Attachment II.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth (10th) day after the passage hereof.
