

AN ORDINANCE **97039**

AMENDING THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT AND AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,170.60 FROM 2000 CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION TO TURNER COLLIE & BRADEN, INC. FOR ADDITIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE BITTERS ROAD FROM WEST AVENUE TO HEIMER (MPO) PROJECT LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 9; AUTHORIZING \$2,017.06 FOR MISCELLANEOUS ENGINEERING CONTINGENCY EXPENSES; REVISING THE PROJECT BUDGET; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 87176, passed and approved on January 8, 1998 authorized a Professional Engineering Services Contract with W.F. Castella and Associates, Inc, in the amount of \$75,000.00 for services in connection with the Bitters Road – Embassy Row to Heimer Project; and

WHEREAS, the project consists of widening the existing roadway to seven (7) lanes, adding left and right turn lanes at U.S. 281 to facilitate traffic through the intersection of U.S. 281, upgrade traffic signalization, and adding 6” sidewalks at the curb; and

WHEREAS, the original contract was with W. F. Castella and Associates, Inc. which is now a subsidiary of Turner Collie & Braden, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2001, Ordinance No. 93191 amended the contract with Turner Collie & Braden, Inc. to provide compensation in an amount of \$60,000.00 for additional services associated with the Bitters Road – West Avenue to Heimer Road Project (formerly Bitters Road – Embassy Row to Heimer Road Project); and

WHEREAS, this ordinance amends the contract with Turner Collie & Braden, Inc. for additional work that is beyond the original scope and provides for compensation in the amount not to exceed \$20,170.60 for the additional services and \$2,017.06 for engineering contingency associated with Bitters Road from West Avenue to Heimer Road Metropolitan Planning Organization Project; and

WHEREAS, the contract is amended to modify the roadway cross-section, driveway details to conform to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements, modify Traffic Control Plan, prepare a Traffic Signal Interconnect Plan and revise the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan layouts to correspond to the revised Traffic Control Plan; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance increases the total authorized for this professional service contract to \$176,970.60, the current construction estimate for this project is \$2,500,000.00; and

WHEREAS, approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of Council policy to construct previously approved Metropolitan Planning Organization 2000 Certificates of Obligation funded Capital Improvement Projects, **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The professional services contract between the City of San Antonio and Turner Collie & Braden, Inc., acting on behalf of W. F. Castella & Associates, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Turner Collie & Braden, Inc. in an amount of \$20,170.60 for additional engineering services in connection with the Bitters Road – West Avenue to Heimer Road Project is hereby authorized. The original contract that was authorized by Ordinance 87176, dated January 8, 1998 is hereby amended in accordance herewith. A copy of the proposal is attached hereto as **Attachment I.**

SECTION 2. The budget in Fund No. 43-070095, 2000 Certificates of Obligation (MPO), shall be revised by reducing Index Code 509315, entitled “Unallocated Appropriations”, in the amount of \$22,187.66.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$20,170.60 is appropriated in Fund No. 43-070004, 2000 Certificates of Obligation (MPO), in Index Code 617415, entitled “Engineering Contract”, and is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to **Turner Collie & Braden, Inc.**, in connection with the Bitters Road from West Avenue to Heimer Road (MPO) Project.

SECTION 4. The amount of \$2,017.06 is appropriated in Fund No. 43-070004, 2000 Certificates of Obligation (MPO), in Index Code 617423, entitled “Engineering Contingency”, and is authorized to be encumbered for engineering contingencies, in connection with the Bitters Road from West Avenue to Heimer Road (MPO) Project.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager’s designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect on the 26th day of January, 2003.
