

AN ORDINANCE **97095**

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$100.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 4 CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FUND, PAYABLE TO THE ADAMS HILL C.O.P., TO BE USED TO REPLACE WORN AND FADED CELLULAR ON PATROL (C.O.P.) SIGNS IN THE ADAMS HILL NEIGHBORHOOD; AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN ENRIQUE MARTIN.

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WHEREAS, Councilman Enrique Martin, District 4, has requested Council concurrence for the expenditure of \$100.00 from the Council District 4 Contingency Fund for replacing worn and faded Cellular on Patrol (C.O.P.) signs in the Adams Hill neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to authorize the expenditure as requested by Councilman Enrique Martin, **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The request of Councilman Enrique Martin, District 4, for reimbursement from the District 4 Contingency Budget Account in the total amount of \$100.00 to Adams Hill C.O.P. is hereby approved and authorized. A copy of Councilman Martin's request is set out in Attachment I.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$100.00 is authorized to be encumbered for payment in the District 4 Contingency Account, Index Code 603555 entitled "District 4 Contingency Fund," and is made payable to Adams Hill C.O.P.


SECTION 3. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Adams Hill C.O.P. in the amount of \$100.00 for replacing worn and faded Cellular on Patrol (C.O.P.) signs in the Adams Hill neighborhood. A copy of the "Agreement to Use Funds of the City of San Antonio" is attached hereto and appearing in substantially the same form as Attachment II.


SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth (10th) day after the passage hereof.
