

AN ORDINANCE 97921

AUTHORIZING PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,500.00 TO DUGGER, CANADAY, GRAFE INCORPORATED, FOR APPRAISAL SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE TEZEL ROAD – TIMBER PATH TO OLD TEZEL PROJECT LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7; APPROPRIATING FUNDS AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.

WHEREAS, appraisal services were required for the Tezel Road – Timber Path to Old Tezel Project and the; and

WHEREAS, charges for such services are reasonable and necessary expenses relating to the above-mentioned projects; **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$6,500.00 is appropriated in Fund 45-970019, General Obligation 2000A Street Bonds, in index code 939405, entitled Transfer to 45-979260 Tezel. The amount of \$6,500.00 is authorized to be transferred from 45-970019 to fund 45-979260.

SECTION 2. The budget in fund 45-979000, 1999 Street Improvements, is revised by increasing Index Code 137711, entitled Trf Fr 45-970019 (45-979260) Tezel by the amount of \$6,500.00.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$6,500.00 is appropriated in Fund 45-979260, 1999 Street Improvements, in index code 421990, entitled Appraisal Fees, and is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to Dugger, Canaday, Grafe, Inc., for appraisal services in connection with the Tezel Road – Timber Path to Old Tezel Project (for **Parcels 16603, 16604, 16606E, 16607E, 16608E, 16609E, 16610E and 16611.**)

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective on August 17, 2003.


