

AN ORDINANCE **97966**

**AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$631.65 FROM THE DISTRICT 1 CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FUND, PAYABLE TO THE U.U. HOUSING ASSISTANCE CORPORATION TO BE USED TO DEFRAY COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE MAILING OF NOTICES TO THE RESIDENTS OF DISTRICT 1 ANNOUNCING A JOINT TOWN HALL MEETING BEING HELD ON AUGUST 9, 2003 BY U.U. HOUSING AND THE OFFICE OF COUNCILMAN ROGER O. FLORES, AS REQUESTED BY COUNCILMAN ROGER O. FLORES.**

**WHEREAS**, Councilman Roger O. Flores has requested Council concurrence for the expenditure of \$631.65 from the District 1 Contingency Fund to help defray costs associated with the mailing of notices to the residents of District 1 announcing a joint Town Hall Meeting being held on August 9, 2003 by U.U. Housing and his office; and

**WHEREAS**, The City Council wishes to authorize the expenditure as requested by Councilman Roger O. Flores, **NOW THEREFORE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The request of Councilman Roger O. Flores, for the authorization to expend funds from the District 1 Contingency Budget Account in the amount of \$631.65 to help defray costs associated with the mailing of notices to residents of District 1 announcing a joint Town Hall Meeting being held on August 9, 2003 by U.U. Housing and his office is hereby approved and authorized. A copy of Councilman Flores' request is set out in Attachment 1 hereof.

**SECTION 2.** The amount of \$631.65 is encumbered for payment in the District 1 Contingency Budget Account, Index Code 603415 entitled District 1 Contingency Fund, and is made payable to the U.U. Housing Assistance Corporation.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the U.U. Housing Assistance Corporation for use of the amount of \$631.65. A copy of the "Agreement to Use Funds of the City of San Antonio" is attached hereto and appearing in substantially the same form as Attachment II.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) day after the passage hereof.
