

AN ORDINANCE **97915**

ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF A 207.513 ACRE TRACT OF LAND AS A PERMANENT DRAINAGE EASEMENT FROM THE TOM SLICK MEMORIAL TRUST FOR SOUTHWEST RESEARCH INSTITUTE AND SOUTHWEST RESEARCH INSTITUTE IN CONNECTION WITH THE CULEBRA/LOOP 410 (LEON CREEK) REGIONAL STORM WATER DETENTION FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio desires to construct certain drainage improvements as part of the Culebra/Loop 410 (Leon Creek) Regional Storm Water Detention Facilities Project upon property owned by the Tom Slick Memorial Trust for Southwest Research Institute and the Southwest Research Institute; and

WHEREAS, the owners have offered to dedicate the needed easement to the City of San Antonio and the City desires to accept the dedication of said easements; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The City of San Antonio hereby accepts, subject to the requirements of Section 2, below, the dedication of a 207.513 acre tract as a Permanent Drainage Easement in New City Block 11493, from the Tom Slick Memorial Trust for Southwest Research Institute, and Southwest Research Institute, for use in the Culebra/Loop 410 (Leon Creek) Regional Storm Water Detention Facilities project. A complete metes and bounds description of the dedicated property is attached hereto (**Exhibit A**) and it is incorporated herein for all purposes as if fully set out.


SECTION 2. A copy of the dedication instrument shall be submitted to the City Attorney for approval under Section 54, Charter of the City of San Antonio. If the City Attorney approves the instrument then the title to the easement shall vest in City of San Antonio in accordance with the terms and conditions of the approved dedication instrument.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective on the 17th day of August, 2003.
