

AN ORDINANCE **97936**

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$146,076.00 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA), THROUGH THE DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OF THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, FOR THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2002 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2003, TO BE USED TO REIMBURSE ONE-HALF OF THE APPROVED ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF AND ADMINISTRATIVE OVERHEAD COSTS OF THE CITY'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT.**

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**WHEREAS**, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), through the Division of Emergency Management of the Texas Department of Public Safety, has offered grant funds in the amount of \$146,076.00 for reimbursement of one-half of the approved administrative staff and administrative overhead costs of the City's Office of Emergency Management; and

**WHEREAS**, the Emergency Management Performance Grant program activities for FY 2003 are a continuation of previous fiscal year's grants, which are designed to ensure that hazards which threaten our cities and counties are clearly identified, improve local emergency planning, enhance the emergency management-related skills of local personnel conduct exercises to test training and validate plans, increase public awareness of the hazards facing the local communities, and to identify and implement vulnerability and risk reduction measures; and

**WHEREAS**, no City matching funds are required; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to accept a grant in the amount of \$146,076.00 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency

(FEMA), through the Division of Emergency Management of the Texas Department of Public Safety, for reimbursement of one-half of the approved administrative staff and administrative overhead costs of the City's Emergency Management Office for the period of October 1, 2002 through September 30, 2003. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all necessary documentation to effect said acceptance.

**SECTION 2.** Fund No. 26-056050, entitled "EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM 2002-2003" is hereby designated for use in accounting for the above grant, and the sum of \$146,076.00 is hereby appropriated as follows:
