

AN ORDINANCE **97938**

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS IN CONNECTION WITH THE AVENIDA GUADALUPE ASSOCIATION'S 22ND ANNUAL GUADALUPE STREET PARADE TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2003 FROM 11:30 A.M. TO 2:00 P.M.

WHEREAS, the **Avenida Guadalupe Association** has applied for a parade permit to hold the "AGA 22nd Annual Guadalupe Street Parade" on Saturday, September 13, 2003 beginning at 11:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, for this event to take place, it will be necessary to temporarily close portions of certain streets to vehicular traffic, as stated in the route in "Section 2" below; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that granting the request will promote the health, safety and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity; and

WHEREAS, the request has been evaluated and it has been found that no adverse traffic problems would result, and that the request should be granted in accordance with the City's usual practice and procedure; **NOW THEREFORE**;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the requested parade permit to the **Avenida Guadalupe Association** so that it may hold the "AGA 22nd Annual Guadalupe Street Parade" on Saturday, September 13, 2003 beginning at 11:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. In order to hold the "AGA 22nd Annual Guadalupe Street Parade" on Saturday, September 13, 2003 beginning at 11:30 a.m. until 2:00 p.m., the temporary closure of portions of the streets listed in the route below to vehicular traffic is hereby authorized:

Assembly Area: Guadalupe between Brazos and Colorado, Brazos between Durango and Guadalupe, San Fernando between Trinity and Brazos, El Paso between Trinity and Brazos

Route: South on Brazos to Guadalupe
West on Guadalupe to Trinity
North on Trinity to Commerce
West on Commerce to Zarzamora
South on Zarzamora to El Paso

Disbanding Area: Zarzamora between Durango and Guadalupe, Elmendorf between Durango and El Paso, El Paso between Hamilton and Zarzamora, San Luis between Elmendorf and Zarzamora, Aztec between Elmendorf and Zarzamora.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

SECTION 4. The **Avenida Guadalupe Association** shall be responsible for the following:

- a) all insurance requirements,
- b) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges,
- c) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and
- d) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 5. The **Avenida Guadalupe Association** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on the 17th day of August, 2003.
