

AN ORDINANCE **9 8 0 9 0**

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH ALAMO WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT, INC. (AWD) FOR OPERATION OF THE ALAMO CHILD CARE DELIVERY SYSTEM (CCDS) AND QUALITY IMPROVEMENT ACTIVITIES (QIA) PROGRAMS FOR THE PERIOD SEPTEMBER 1, 2003 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2005; AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A FIRST YEAR ALLOCATION GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$32,760,234.00 FOR THE OPERATION OF THESE PROGRAMS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003-2004; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF DELEGATE AGENCY CONTRACTS WITH ALAMO AREA DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION (AADC) AND FAMILY SERVICE ASSOCIATION OF SAN ANTONIO (FSA) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$701,955.00 AND \$409,951.00, RESPECTIVELY, IN CONNECTION WITH THE OPERATION OF THE ALAMO CCDS AND QIA PROGRAMS; AND APPROVING A BUDGET AND PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT; EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY IF PASSED BY AT LEAST EIGHT VOTES.

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WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio, through its Children's Resources Division of the Department of Community Initiatives responded to a Request for Proposals by Alamo Workforce Development, Inc. (AWD) for operation of the Alamo Child Care Delivery System (CCDS) and Quality Improvement Activities (QIA) Programs for the Alamo Workforce Development Area; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio, through its Children's Resources Division of the Department of Community Initiatives, in connection with its co-applicants the Alamo Area Development Corporation (AADC) and the Family Service Association of San Antonio (FSA) has successfully been awarded a contract with AWD, to serve as the operator for the Alamo CCDS and QIA Programs for the period of September 1, 2003 through August 31, 2005 for the Alamo Workforce Development Area; and

WHEREAS, AWD has awarded funds for fiscal year 2004 in the amount of \$32,760,234.00 for the provision of child care services in the Alamo CCDS program; and

WHEREAS, AWD's contract with the City states that the City may execute delegate agency contracts with AADC and FSA in the amount of \$701,955.00 and \$409,951.00, respectively, for the provision of child care services and quality initiatives; and

WHEREAS, because child care services would not be otherwise provided if this ordinance were not made immediately effective, for the preservation of public peace, property, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared such that the City Council deems it necessary that this ordinance become effective at once, upon passage with at least eight (8) affirmative votes; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to accept an award from the Alamo Workforce Development, Inc. (AWD) in the amount of \$32,760,234.00 to operate the Alamo Child Care Delivery System (CCDS) and the Quality Improvement Activities (QIA) Programs for the period

beginning September 1, 2003 and ending August 31, 2004 for the first year of a two year grant for operation of said program.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to execute a contract with AWD for the operation of the Alamo CCDS and QIA programs for the period beginning September 1, 2003 and ending August 31, 2005. A copy of the contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives, is authorized to execute Delegate Agency Contracts with the Alamo Area Development Corporation (AADC) and the Family Service Association of San Antonio (FSA) in the amounts of \$701,955.00 and \$409,951.00, respectively, in connection with the operation of said programs. Copies of the delegate agency contracts are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment II.

SECTION 4. The budget for Project No. 26-039016 entitled "Child Care Delivery System Program 2003 – 2004", attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment III, is hereby established for said program year beginning September 1, 2003 and ending August 31, 2004.

SECTION 5. The personnel complement, including the transfer of current filled and vacant positions between grant activities within the project, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment IV, is hereby approved.

SECTION 6. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, may correct the allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 7. Pursuant to and for the purpose of complying with Article II, Section 15 of the City's Charter, this ordinance is hereby passed as an emergency measure and shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight (8) or more affirmative votes for the preservation of public peace, property, health or safety; otherwise, the same will take effect on the tenth (10th) day after the date of its passage by the City Council.
