

AN ORDINANCE **98056**

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF TWO (2) RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT AGREEMENTS WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT IN CONNECTION WITH THE LAYING OUT, CONSTRUCTING AND RECONSTRUCTING OF THE INTERSECTION OF NORTHEAST LOOP 410 AND U.S. HIGHWAY 281 FOR A TOTAL COMPENSATION TO THE CITY OF \$1,046,200.00.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) plans to construct a four-level interchange with ramps directly connecting US Highway 281 to and from Northeast Loop 410 near the San Antonio International Airport (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, as part of the Project Loop 410 will also be widened and new bridges will be constructed at this same intersection; and

WHEREAS, the pending highway construction will assist the City of San Antonio by upgrading current roadway systems, improving traffic flow, and relieving the Airport of heavy through traffic; and

WHEREAS, in order for TxDOT to use Airport property in connection with the Project, it is necessary to execute Right-of-Way Easement Agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has recommended approval for the change in use of City-Owned property at the airport; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager’s designee is hereby authorized to execute the attached Right-of-Way Easement Agreements with the Texas Department of Transportation.


Section 2. Payment received in connection with said agreement shall be deposited in Fund 51-001000 (Airport Operations and Maintenance Account) in index code 031302 entitled “Airport – Other” in the amount of \$440,150.00 and in Fund 51-013200 (Facility Relocation for TXDot) in index code 082354 entitled “Facility Relocation for TXDot” in the amount of \$606,050.00.

Section 3. The Director of Finance is authorized to make the necessary entries to adjust the budgets in Fund 51-00100 and Fund 51-013200 as a result of Right-of-Way Easement Agreements with Texas Department of Transportation.

Section 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to the concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of the Ordinance.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.


